## Year End Reminders

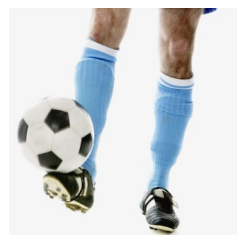

## Scholarship Opportunity for K-5 Students

We want to highly encourage all families of students going into **grades K-5** to check out the **Step Up for Students** scholarship. If you qualify, you could receive a scholarship of **\$4335**. If several families are able to obtain this scholarship, it will help SFCA's financial aid dollars go much further. They have removed the requirement that students in grades K-5 must have attended a Florida public school, so many of our current families will now qualify. If your family income meets these guidelines, you should apply:
